In 1958, Boise Rescue Mission started as a small soup kitchen with just a few cots to feed and shelter homeless people. Today, we have multiple facilities in Boise and Nampa that, in 2018, served 363,327 meals and provided 172,662 nights of shelter, and create opportunities to recover from homelessness for hundreds of men, women, and children in need. Boise Rescue Mission Ministries is able to provide services to homeless and hungry people in our community with no government assistance thanks to the generosity of our donors and community partners.

## PROGRAMS OFFERED:

**New Life Recovery Program** - Helping those struggling with substance abuse overcome their addiction and build new, better lives.

**Emergency Services** (also called "Guest Services") - Providing nutritious meals and safe, secure facilities for men, and for women and children in Boise and Nampa. This is often the first step in the pathway to other opportunities to recover from homelessness.

**Programs for Children and Teens** - Working to break the cycle of homelessness and to drastically improve the futures of homeless children in the Treasure Valley through education, counseling, and activities.

**Education and Career Development** - Providing education, job search assistance, work ethics training, and financial accountability programs to help our guests address the root cause of their homelessness and return to society.

**Veteran's Ministry Program** - Serving chronically homeless veterans in partnership with the VA and working to help them regain their independence.

**Mental Health Program** - Offering assessment, counseling and crisis management to every individual in need who comes through our doors so that men, women, and children battling mental health issues may achieve stability and begin to rebuild their lives.

**Community Outreach** - Giving help to more than just homeless people! Families and individuals in need across the Treasure Valley receive food assistance throughout the year along with clothing, shoes, and household items, all free of charge. During the holidays we organize Thanksgiving and Christmas banquets, food boxes for the community, and toys for children in need through Toys for Tots.
