In 1958, Boise Rescue Mission started as a small soup kitchen with just a few cots to feed and shelter homeless people. Today, we have multiple facilities in Boise and Nampa that, in 2018, served 363,327 meals and provided 172,662 nights of shelter, in addition to teaching the Word of God and creating opportunities to recover from homelessness for hundreds of men, women, and children in need. Boise Rescue Mission Ministries is able to provide services to homeless and hungry people in our community with no government assistance thanks to the generosity of our donors and community partners.

## WE'RE HERE WHEN YOU NEED A HAND UP!

**Addressing Immediate Needs** - Guest Services is our ministry to those in need of Emergency Shelter. Boise Rescue Mission Ministries is committed to caring for every man, woman and child in need across the Treasure Valley, no matter where they are in life. If someone is homeless or struggling and in need of a hot meal or a safe place to stay, he or she can visit one of our emergency shelters in Boise or Nampa, - no prior arrangements are necessary.

**More than a Meal** - Guest Services is also much more than the traditional "three hots and a cot". At all four of our shelters, our goal is to help each guest leave homelessness and enter into a new and better future. To that end, we offer comprehensive services to address the root causes of homelessness in each person's life. Individual case management, work search training, financial accountability programs, and mental health services all work together to achieve that goal - and we are seeing real results!
