PROGRAMS OFFERED:

New Life Discipleship & Recovery Program - Helping those struggling with substance abuse overcome addiction and build new, better lives.

Emergency Services - Providing nutritious meals and safe, secure facilities for men, and for women and children in Boise and Nampa. This is often the first step in the pathway to other opportunities to recover from homelessness.

Programs for Children and Teens - Working to break the cycle of homelessness and to drastically improve the futures of homeless children in the Treasure Valley through education, counseling, and activities.

Community Outreach - Giving help to families and individuals in need with food assistance, clothing, household items, Thanksgiving and Christmas banquets, food boxes and toys - all free of charge.

Veteran's Ministry Program - Serving chronically homeless veterans in partnership with the VA and working to help them regain their independence.

Mental Health Program - Connecting guests with community resources that provide mental health assessments, counseling, and crisis management.

Respite Program - Providing wrap-around support services to guests with medical issues that can't be effectively addressed in a typical emergency shelter environment.

Education and Career Development - Providing education, job search assistance, work ethics training, and financial accountability programs to help our guests address the root cause of their homelessness and return to society.

In 1958, Boise Rescue Mission started as a small soup kitchen in Boise, with just a few cots to feed and shelter homeless people. Today, the Mission has grown into five shelter facilities in Boise and Nampa, including two men's shelters, two shelters exclusively for women and children, and the Recovery Lodge that houses the Mission's Medical Respite Program.

We reach out to the community by teaching the Word of God and providing opportunities to recover from homelessness for hundreds of men, women, and children in need. Boise Rescue Mission Ministries is able to provide services to homeless and hungry people in our community with no government assistance thanks to the generosity of our donors and community partners.
