In 1958, Boise Rescue Mission started as a small soup kitchen in Boise, with just a few cots to feed and shelter homeless people. Today, the Mission has grown into five shelter facilities in Boise and Nampa, including two men's shelters, two shelters exclusively for women and children, and the Recovery Lodge that houses the Mission's Medical Respite Program.

We reach out to the community by teaching the Word of God and providing opportunities to recover from homelessness for hundreds of men, women, and children in need. Boise Rescue Mission Ministries is able to provide services to homeless and hungry people in our community with no government assistance thanks to the generosity of our donors and community partners.

## WE'RE HERE WHEN YOU NEED A HAND UP!

**Addressing Immediate Needs** - Guest Services is what we call our ministry to people in the Treasure Valley who need emergency overnight shelter. Boise Rescue Mission Ministries is committed to caring for every man, woman, and child in need across the Treasure Valley, no matter where they are in life. If someone is homeless or struggling and in need of a hot meal or a safe place to stay, they can come to one of our emergency shelters in Boise or Nampa - no prior arrangements are necessary.

**More than a Meal** - Guest Services is also much more than the traditional "three hots and a cot". At all five of our shelters, our goal is to help each guest leave homelessness and enter into a new and better future. To that end, we offer comprehensive services to address the root causes of homelessness in each person's life. Individual case management, work search training, financial accountability programs, and mental health services all work together to achieve that goal - and we are seeing real results!
