Dear Friend,

Over the course of 65 years of ministry to homeless and hurting men, women, and children across the Treasure Valley, we have heard thousands of testimonies from people who came to Boise Rescue Mission Ministries for help and found more than a meal or a clean, safe place to sleep. They found welcoming staff and kind words. They found people who were genuinely interested in building a relationship with them; folks who believed in them and were willing to become their extended family. And many found new hope in the message of God's love that they heard and experienced here.

Since the Rescue Mission began, more than 22,850 individuals have shared with a staff member that they made the decision to follow Christ. For some of these people, that decision led them out of addiction and criminal conduct. For many, it meant returning to a family and making amends. For others, it simply meant finding a job and becoming responsible for themselves again. For all of them it meant living for Christ rather than living for self alone.

I want you to know that the prayers and support of people like you for this work of Rescue are responsible for these changed lives. We are so appreciative of your heart for the Rescue Mission and the people we serve. I thank you and I hope, as you join us in prayer and meditation on God's word for the next 30 days, that you will be blessed and encouraged, and will find strength for the challenges you yourself are facing. We've included a place for you to write your own thoughts and prayers.

DAY 1

Pray that God would bless the people in our facilities with faith and a hunger to know Him.

My thoughts and prayers:

DAY 2

DAY 3

DAY 5

DAY 6

Pray our guests would experience love, compassion, and understanding from our staff and volunteers.

Pray that those we service may encounter the love of God in the meals, shelter, and care we provide.

- Philippians 4:7

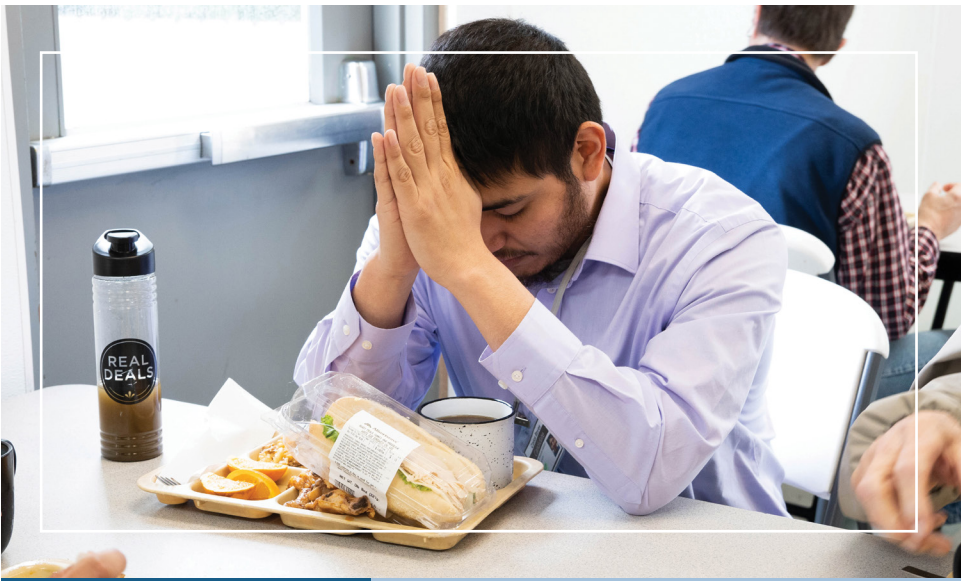


DAY 10

DAY 11

DAY 24

Pray that our Kids Program staff would shine Christ's light in all they do, and provide a good example of what it means to live well.

DAY 25

- Psalm 91:1,2

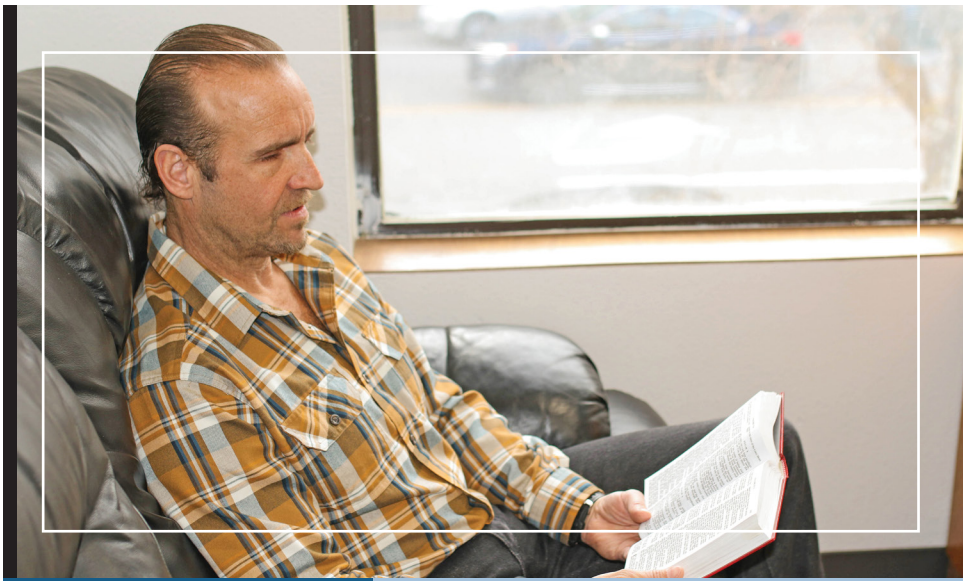


DAY 26
