The Cradle of Hope Program aims to fill the "gap needs" in crisis pregnancy care in the Treasure Valley while partnering with local life-affirming pregnancy clinics, churches, and other organizations.

It is more important than ever to reach out to women and men alike, reminding them that they are not alone, that their lives have value, that life is the first gift from God and the first unalienable right outlined in the Declaration of Independence, and that each human being - including the unborn - is made in the image of God, and therefore infinitely precious.

In 1958, Boise Rescue Mission started as a small soup kitchen with just a few cots to feed and shelter homeless people.

The Rescue Mission is committed to teaching the Word of God and caring for anyone in need across the Treasure Valley, no matter where they are in life.

Our facilities and staff work hard to offer people a hand up in life, not just a handout. Our programs create real opportunities for men, women, and children to recover from homelessness, rebuild their lives, and successfully return to independent living.
